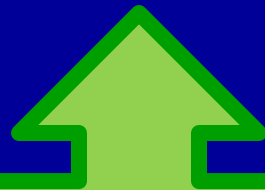

Benefits of a smart uniform:

- Instils pride;
- Supports positive behaviour and discipline;
- Encourages identity with, and support for our Meadowside school ethos;
- Ensures all pupils feel equal and welcome;
- Protects children from social pressures to dress in a particular way;
- Nurtures cohesion and promotes good relations between different groups of pupils.
- Above all, we believe that school uniform supports effective teaching and learning.
- Uniform encourages a sense of belonging
- Dressing for school is associated with positive healthy habits



Here are a few reminders/school etiquette:

- No hoodies/jackets/coats in class
- No NAILS (acrylic or stick on) OR
- EAR head bands



- Save non-uniform for our non-uniform days...it makes it even more special then!



- Hands out of pockets
- Speak to a school adult if there needs to be special consideration

Shoes



- Smart, sensible black shoes



OUTDOOR SHOES: can be any old trainers or wellies and they live in your outdoor shoe rack. This means you can access muddy zones... but only in **THESE SHOES!**

Skirts



- Skirts must be a sensible length
- Skirts can only be worn with tights or socks.
- They are grey

PE lessons

- These are very comfortable...just make sure everything is labelled so you can find your belongings.
- TOP TIP: put everything in your PE bag as soon as you get changed either into it or out of it!



Jewellery

- Small studs are allowed **BUT NOT** on PE days. We have to keep you safe!

- A wrist watch
